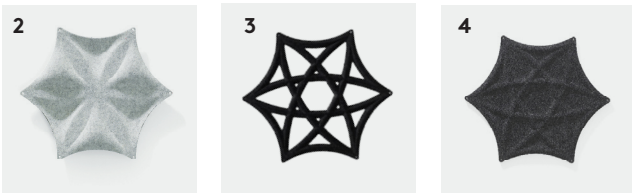
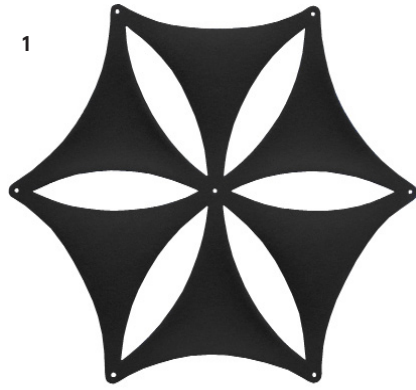


Airflake

1. Airflake XL, blade open
2. Airflake, blade closed
3. Airflake, line open
4. Airflake, line closed

Materials and sustainability:

Felt-laminated moulded fibre felt.
Assembled together with small plastic clips.
Ceiling- or wall hung with an aluminium rail.

There is no emission to air, water or soil during its production.

The sound absorbent filling contains recycled materials.

Measurements WxHxD (mm)

360x400 (Airflake blade open, blade closed, line open, line closed)

600x700 (Airflake XL, blade open)

Airflake is a modular system built around the shape of a hexagon.

This product includes a variety of designs and colors, which can be combined to create flexible hanging screens on walls and ceilings.

The key feature of this product is the possibility of creating a more dynamic visual space while diffusing unpleasant sound reflections.

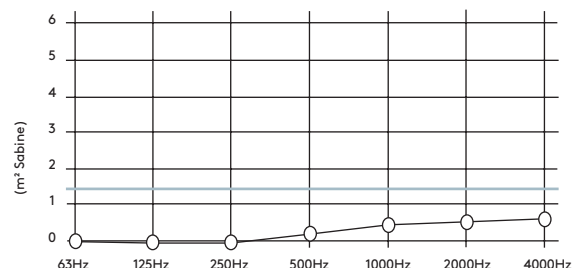


Diffusion
